#### **Old Business:**

#### a. Review changes to the Park Plan

Timmins stated that the 5-Year Parks and Recreation plan has been available for public review. Copies of the plan have been available at the Acme Township hall for review and on the web at <a href="https://www.acmefuture.org">www.acmefuture.org</a>

Tonight we are looking for any additional corrections and then a motion to move on to the December Board for final approval.

Timmins reviewed the changes the Parks & Rec advisory made, the addition of another Hawk/Pedestrian cross walk at the northside of Bayside park, a spot to leave canoes and kayaks and up grade the emergency area to grass pavers.

Motion by Feringa, seconded by Kaetchen to approve and forward the 5-Year Parks and Recreation plan to the Acme Township Board for their approval. Motion carried.

Timmins provided a letter from the Grand Traverse Watershed and DEQ that all e-coli beach monitor funding has been diverted to downstate areas for 2014. The Watershed encouraged area townships to express concerns and issues to our local government representation at the State level. Timmins and Goss will prepare a letter for review by the Advisory.
