Henkel's park report

Henkel reported that the Parks are closed and have been winterized. The gate at Bayside will remain open until further notice.

Henkel has been working on the topsoil at the Shoreline. He has been spreading, seeding and fertilizing this week. As weather permits he will be picking up the leaves.

Christy Summers, of Beckett and Raeder, review the conceptual site plan for the South end of Bayside park. Discussion followed.

Summers also presented schematic design cost estimates for the parcel adjacent to Mount Hope Road and the parcel adjacent to Bunker Hill Road. Discussion followed.

Motion by Kaetchen, seconded by Challender to accept the north and south Bayside park proposals from Beckett & Raeder as presented with the addition of another Hawk/Pedestrian Cross walk with activated signal at the northside of Bayside park, a spot to leave canoes and kayaks and up grade the emergency area to grass pavers. Motion carried.

Timmins said the 5-Year Parks and Recreation plan is available for public review and comment. Copies of the plan are available for review during regular business hours at the Acme Township hall or on the web at www.acmefuture.org.

Timmins also informed the advisory that the rustic campground connected to Sayler Park is on the market for a reasonable price of \$160,000.00. Discussion.
